

PORT OF OAKLAND NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A

Negative Declaration for

Radius Recycling Oakland Nonferrous Scrap Materials Enclosures and Conveyor Project, Oakland, California

To: Public Agencies and Concerned Citizens/Interested Parties From: Port of Oakland Environmental Programs and Planning 530 Water Street Oakland, CA 94607

Project Applicant: Radius Recycling (formerly Schnitzer Steel Industries, Inc.)

Notice: Notice is hereby given that the Port of Oakland (Port), acting as Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), will receive public comment and recommendations on a draft Initial Study (IS)/Negative Declaration (ND) for the Radius Recycling Oakland Nonferrous Scrap Materials Enclosures and Conveyor Project (the project). The review period extends for 30 days beginning May 6, 2024, and ends at 5:00 pm on June 5, 2024. All comments regarding the draft IS/ND must be received by this ending date/time. The Port intends to approve a Port development permit for the project upon adoption of the final IS/ND.

Project Location: The project site is located at the Radius Recycling Oakland facility, 1101 Embarcadero West, Oakland, California 94607.

Project Description: Radius Recycling is proposing to construct three buildings (Buildings A, B, and C) to enclose existing storage and processing of nonferrous scrap materials (materials that do not contain iron) and other operations. In addition, a new conveyor would be constructed inside the proposed Building A to minimize the need for multiple handling of the nonferrous scrap materials. The buildings and conveyor would be constructed and operated at Radius Recycling's existing scrap metal and recovery facility near the Port in Oakland, California.

Potential Environmental Impacts: No significant, unavoidable impacts have been identified.

Comment Period: The public review period for the draft IS/ND extends from May 6, 2024, and ends at 5:00 p.m. on June 5, 2024.

Locations Where Document Can Be Reviewed: The Port has prepared a draft IS/ND for the subject project pursuant to CEQA.
