The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) released a final rule in January 2007, for the use of a Transportation Worker Identification Credential (TWIC) by all personnel requiring unescorted access to a secure / restricted area of a maritime port facility. This includes longshore workers, truckers, terminal operators, vendors and contractors.

The Port of Oakland's role is to help facilitate the local outreach effort by Transportation Security Administration (TSA) and their contractors, Lockheed Martin and Deloitte and Touche, to those impacted by these new regulations.
