#### **I. Planning Session – Construction Workforce Forum**

The team selected to plan the Construction Workforce Forum felt that the timing was not right to hold forum due to the high union unemployment and the need to know what will be coming out of the Economic Stimulus package. In lieu of having the forum it was decided that the following activities should be undertaken.

- Focus on the retention of existing local apprentices that are presently working or not working.
- Need to find out how OFCCP (Office of Federal Contract Compliance) will go about enforcing employment standards that will pertain to the construction funding coming out of the Economic Stimulus package.
- Get the Division of Apprenticeship Standards (DAS) actively involved in all planning efforts going forth.
- Set up a meeting with Bill Smithson of OFCCP concerning enforcement of employment standards for the Economic Stimulus funding.
- Engage the offices of Representative Barbara Lee to assist our efforts
- Need to consider how to get the community organized concerning the federal funding and how to get local residents employed.
