#### **I Social Justice Trustees Meeting/September 3rd**

The Social Justice Trustees met on September 3<sup>rd</sup>. The Trustees approved the following actions at the meeting.

- Accepted recommendation to fund the Retention Project
- Accepted recommendation to add the acquisition of the TWIC cards as an authorized expenditure from the Tool & Equipment Account
- Accepted recommendation to have the Oakland Private Industry Council continue to serve as the Fiscal Agent for the Tool & Equipment Account

#### **II Public Comment-Use of Project Labor Agreements/Federal Construction Projects**

Executive Order 13502 issued by President Obama on February 6<sup>th</sup> repealed two previous Executive Orders by the Bush Administration and which permits the use of PLA's on federally assisted public works projects has engendered legal issues. The Port of Oakland has requested that agencies and organizations in the community send supporting comments to the FAR to recommend to the federal government that local agencies, such as the Port of Oakland to apply its MAPLA program to all federally assisted public works projects immediately. Public comments are due by September 23<sup>rd</sup> by 11.59 Pm EST. John indicated that he would disseminate the information to community based organizations to solicit their support. Robyn Hodges will share the information with Supervisor Nate Miley to see if the County will be willing to also respond in support of the issue.

#### **III. Other Business**

Meg Vasey was in attendance and was introduced as the new Executive Director of Tradeswomen, Inc.
