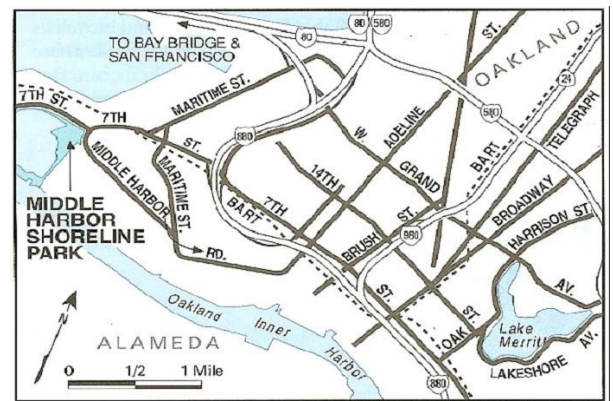
LOW TIDE EXPLORATION
