



## Public Notice to Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (ACDBE)

### Be Part of Oakland International Airport's Future Become ACDBE Certified

Oakland International Airport (OAK) is now the second largest airport in the San Francisco Bay Area and is ranked third among U.S. airports for serving the highest proportion of domestic passengers (74%) using "low-cost" service. With carriers offering fewer in-flight amenities, there is growing opportunity for new concession concepts.

If you are interested in participating in the Port's Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (ACDBE) program, you must be certified through the California Unified Certification Program. Participation as a certified ACDBE helps the Port meet its goals of inclusion of emerging businesses in the Port's operations.

For consideration towards fulfilling the ACDBE goal, businesses must be ACDBE certified. Start the certification process now as certifying agencies have up to 90 days to certify businesses once a complete package is received.
