Addendum No. 1 RFP No.: 16-17/06, Bond Underwriting Services

This Addendum modifies the original RFP Documents for the above mentioned RFP. Acknowledge receipt of this addendum in the space provided on the RFP Acknowledgement and Signature Form (Attachment 3). Failure to do so may disqualify your proposal.

The following questions were submitted by the deadline and are answered in this addendum.

1. **Question**: Can companies from Outside USA (e.g., from India or Canada) can apply for this?

Response: Yes.

2. **Question**: Do companies need to come over there for meetings?

Response: Yes, the personnel listed in response to the RFP Submission Requirements # 3 should be available if requested by the Port.

3. **Question**: Can we perform the tasks (related to RFP) from outside USA like, from India or Canada?

Response: This is a decision of the underwriting firm.

4. **Question**: Can we submit the proposals via email?

Response: No.

5. **Question**: I see that one of the requirements to serve as senior underwriter is having senior managed at least three greater than \$100 million financings. Does serving as cosenior manager count as meeting this requirement?

Response: No

6. **Question**: Attachment 5-A and 5-B relates to sub-contracting, however the RFP specifically requires us to submit individual proposals. Could you please reconcile that difference?

Response: Attachments 5-A and 5-B are standard forms used by the Port's Social Responsibility Division to assess the utilization of small and/or local businesses in all of its contracting activity. It is not the Port's intention that Respondents to this RFP use the sections of the forms related to sub-contractors.

On Attachment 5-A, Respondents should only provide information for themselves and only fill-in the first row of the table reserved for "Prime" contractor. The remaining rows reserved for "Sub" should be left blank. On Attachment 5-B, Respondents should refer to themselves where the form uses the term "team".
