The CITY OF OAKLAND, acting by and through its BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (the "Port"), will receive sealed Bids at the office of the Secretary of the Board of Port Commissioners, located at Room 629, 530 Water Street, Oakland, California, until 12:00 noon on Tuesday, May 30, 2017, for the following public work:

## REROOFING OF BUILDING M-911 AIRCRAFT RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING FACILITY (ARFF) SOUTH FIELD OAKLAND INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA

The work of this 150 calendar day project consists, in general, of furnishing all labor, materials, appliances, tools, equipment, transportation, services and supervision required to complete the Reroofing of Building M-911, Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Facility (ARFF) at the South Field, including, but not limited to demolition of existing roofing, installation of fully adhered single ply membrane roofing, installation of pre-engineered access stair and landings, and installation of fall protection system; and performing all associated work, including temporary work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$1,120,000.

A California Class B contractor's license is required to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract. The firm performing the roofing work must hold a California Class C-39 license.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

This contract is subject to prevailing wage provisions, as specified in Document 00100, Invitation to Bid, and Document 00200, Instructions to Bidders, of the Project Manual.

The Port will conduct a pre-bid meeting at 11:00 a.m. on Wednesday, May 10, 2017 at the Oakland Maintenance Center (OMC) Hangar Building, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor Auditorium, 1100 Airport Drive, Oakland, California.

It is strongly recommended that bidders attend the pre-bid meeting. The pre-bid meeting will last approximately one hour, and will address the Port's Non-Discrimination and Small/Local Business Utilization Policy, insurance requirements, bonds, Maritime and Aviation Project Labor Agreement and any other special working conditions for this contract.

The project site is in a restricted area. The Port will conduct a Site inspection tour on Wednesday, May 10, 2017 immediately following the pre-bid conference. Bidders should meet for the Site inspection tour in front of the entrance to Terminal 2, 1 Airport Drive, Oakland, California. Bidders

A Government issued photo ID will be required for entry into the project site. Bidders will be taken in Port buses to the Site. Bidders who fail to contact Vincent Chu as required above may not be eligible to participate in the tour.
