## ADDENDUM NO. 3

This Addendum No. 3 is part of the Contract Documents and its receipt shall be acknowledged on Document 00400, Bid Form.

#### 1. DOCUMENT 00100 - INVITATION TO BID, page 00100-1

REVISE the first paragraph of the Invitation to Bid to read as follows:

"The CITY OF OAKLAND, acting by and through its BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (the "Port"), will receive sealed Bids at the office of the Secretary of the Board of Port Commissioners, located at Room 629, 530 Water Street, Oakland, California, until 12:00 noon on Tuesday, July 16, 2019 for the following public work:"

## 2. DOCUMENT 00200 - INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS, page 00200-1

REVISE the first sentence of Paragraph 1, Receipt of Bids, to read as follows:

"The Port will receive sealed bids from Bidders until 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, July 16, 2019."

#### 3. DOCUMENT 00200 - INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS, page 00200-13

REVISE the first sentence of Paragraph 25, Award, to read as follows:

"If the Contract is to be awarded, it will be awarded to the lowest responsible responsive Bidder within ninety (90) days of Bid opening."

# 4. <u>DOCUMENT 00320 – EXISTING CONDITIONS AND GEOTECHNICAL DATA, page</u> 00320-2

REVISE subparagraph 1.02.D.10 to read as follows:

"10. Final Report – Geotechnical Data and Coastal Conditions Report for Perimeter Dike, Oakland International Airport, Oakland, California, prepared by URS Corporation, dated May 6, 2011."

Note that the referenced report was posted to the Port's hosting website under the filename "4172-Reference Materials Pt 5.pdf".

## 5. ADDENDUM NO. 2 DOCUMENT 00400 - BID FORM

DISCARD Addendum No. 2 Document 00400, Bid Form, and REPLACE with the attached Addendum No. 3 Document 00400. Bidder shall use the attached Addendum No. 3 Bid Form to submit its Bid.

The sole revision to the Bid Form consists of extending the award period from sixty days to ninety days.

# 6. SECTION 01100 – SUMMARY OF WORK, page 01100-8

REVISE the second sentence of the description for Bid Item No. 26 to read as follows:

"The Work of this Bid Item includes advancing the CPT probe, record keeping, and reporting as per the requirements of the Plans and as described in Section 02741, Cone Penetration Tests."

## 7. SECTION 02265 – CEMENT-BENTONITE CUTOFF WALL, page 02265-1

REVISE subparagraph 1.02.B to read as follows:

"B. Section 02741, Cone Penetration Tests"".

## 8. SECTION 02265 - CEMENT-BENTONITE CUTOFF WALL, page 02265-11

REVISE the second sentence of subparagraph 3.04.A to read as follows:

"Excavate vertically and construct the cutoff wall to a depth of 2 feet below the top of the YBM as determined by CPT data obtained prior to slurry trench cutoff wall as specified in Section 02741, *Cone Penetration Tests.*"

## 9. SECTION 02464 – STEEL SHEET PILE, page 02464-1

REVISE subparagraph 1.02.B to read as follows:

"B. Section 02741, Cone Penetration Tests."

#### 10. SECTION 02464 - STEEL SHEET PILE, page 02464-4

REVISE the second sentence of subparagraph 3.01.A to read as follows:

"Steel sheet pile wall shall be driven to a depth of 2 feet below the top of the Young Bay Mud as determined by CPT data obtained prior to installation of steel sheet pile wall as specified in Section 02741, *Cone Penetration Tests.*".

#### 11. SECTION 02464 - STEEL SHEET PILE, page 02464-6

REVISE subparagraph 3.02.J to read as follows:

"J. Painting Sheet Pile: Paint exposed road-facing surfaces of sheet piles above grade between STA 40+50 and STA 51+00 in accordance with Section 09900, *Exterior Metal Painting.*"

#### 12. SECTION 09900 - EXTERIOR METAL PAINTING, page 09900-2

REVISE subparagraph 3.01 to read as follows:

"Paint exposed road-facing surfaces of sheet piles above grade between STA 40+50 and STA 51+00 with the approved paint color.
