## SHORE POWER COMPUTER AND PLC REPLACEMENT OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA

The work of this 390 calendar day project consists, in general, of furnishing all labor, materials, appliances, tools, equipment, transportation, services and supervision required to upgrade and standardize all 12 existing computers in the Port of Oakland Shore Power Substations at Berth 24, Berth 25, Berth 30, Berth 32, Berth 35, Berth 37, Berth 55, Berth 56, Berth 57, Berth 58, Berth 59, and Berth 68, including, but not limited to new industrial computers and the latest iFix software; standardize the Programmable Logic Controllers (PLCs) at Shore Power Substations for Berths 24, 56, 57, and 58 to match existing PLCs at other Shore Power Substations; update firmware on remaining PLCs; and perform all associated work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$625,000.

A California Class C10 contractor's license is required to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded any contract for the project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a).

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.
