 - No Response:5%
 - West Oakland: 55%
 - East Oakland: 7%
 - Rest of Oakland: 38%





FROM GARBAGE TC DIRT: The Decomposing Time line




How often do you visit Middle Harbor Shoreline Park?






How do you use Middle Harbor Shoreline Park? Check all that apply.
