Background

The Port of Oakland (Port) is the local land use authority for Radius Recycling (formerly Schnitzer Steel Industries), privately-owned property located at 1101 Embarcadero West, Oakland, CA. Radius Recycling is proposing to construct and operate a 14,000-square-foot containment tent near the eastern boundary of its Oakland facility (Proposed Project) to contain recyclable non-ferrous scrap metals from the facility's recycling process.

On December 4, 2023 the Port released for public review a Draft Initial Study Proposed Negative Declaration (IS/ND) for the proposed project. The 45-day public review and comment period on the Draft IS/ND began on December 4, 2023 and concluded on January 18, 2024. No substantive comments were received. Therefore, the IS/ND is considered final and is available for public review on the Port's web site at <https://www.portofoakland.com/business/bids-rfps/bid-engineering/permits/>

Notice of Decision

A Notice of Decision, giving public notice of the Executive Director's decision, will be distributed to interested parties and posted on the Port's web site following the public hearing.

Absent an administrative appeal, the Executive Director's decision announced in the Notice of Decision will become final fifteen (15) days after issuance of the Notice of Decision. Any person seeking to appeal the Executive Director's decision may file a written notice of appeal to Board of Port Commissioners. The written notice must set forth the specific grounds of the appeal and the appellant must pay the associated administrative appeal fee. Such notice of appeal must be filed within fourteen (14) days after issuance of the Notice of Decision.
