

**NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF BIDS
[REVISED]**

The CITY OF OAKLAND, acting by and through its BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (the "Port"), will receive sealed Bids at the office of the Secretary of the Board of Port Commissioners, located at Room 629, 530 Water Street, Oakland, California, until 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 6, 2017, for the following public work:

The work of this 120 calendar day project consists, in general, of furnishing all labor, materials, appliances, tools, equipment, transportation, services and supervision required to complete the Demolition of Pump House No. 3 and Storm Drainage Improvements at the Oakland International Airport, including, but not limited to: demolishing and removing the pump house and other related storm drain items; excavating; backfilling; grading; installing 36-inch storm drain pipe and fittings; installing flared end section with rock slope protection; installing safety railing; and performing all associated work, including temporary work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$215,000.

A California Class A contractor's license is required prior to award of this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project (submitted on or after March 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)].

No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project (awarded on or after April 1, 2015) unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

This contract is subject to prevailing wage provisions, as specified in Document 00100, Invitation to Bid, and Document 00200, Instructions to Bidders, of the Project Manual.

This project is set aside for certified Small Business Enterprises (SBEs). SBE certifications will be acceptable from all bonafide SBE certifying agencies, including, but not limited to, the following agencies: Port of Oakland - SBE or VSBE, City of Oakland - SLBE, AC Transit - SLBE, Alameda County - SLEB, Small Business Administration - 8(a), Bay Area Rapid Transit (BART) - SBE and California Department of General Services (GSA) - SB or Micro Business (MB). Only bids from certified SBEs will be accepted and proof of certification must be submitted with the bid in order to be qualified as an SBE for this project. Bids submitted by firms that are not certified SBEs will be returned. Those seeking SBE certification with the Port of Oakland, must submit a complete application with supporting documentation no later than seven (7) business days prior to the bid due date. qualified bids are received from eligible, certified SBEs, new bids will be solicited from other bidders.

The Port will conduct a pre-bid meeting at the following time and place: 9:00 A.M. on Tuesday, May 23, 2017 in the Oakland Maintenance Center (OMC) Hangar Building, 2nd Floor Auditorium, 1100 Airport Drive, Oakland, California.

It is strongly recommended that bidders attend the pre-bid meeting. The pre-bid meeting will last approximately one hour, and will address Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation, insurance requirements, bonds, Maritime and Aviation Project Labor Agreement and any other special working conditions for this contract.

The project site is in a restricted area. The Port will conduct one inspection tour of the project site on Tuesday, May 23, 2017. The tour will depart promptly after the pre-bid meeting. Bidders should meet for the Site inspection tour in front of the entrance to the Oakland Maintenance Center (OMC), 1100 Airport Drive, Oakland, California. Bidders must contact Vincent Chu, at (510) 627-1232, at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled tour date and time to confirm arrangements and to register for the inspection tour by providing the tour participant's full name, date of birth, telephone number and company name. A government issued picture ID (e.g., driver's license, State ID, passport) will be required for entry into the project site. Bidders will be taken in Port buses to the project site. Bidders who fail to contact Vincent Chu as required above may not be eligible to participate in the tour.
