**REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS  
ON-CALL AIR QUALITY CONSULTING SERVICES**

The Port of Oakland (Port) is soliciting proposals from qualified consultants for “on-call” air quality technical consulting services to support its Maritime Air Quality Improvement Plan (MAQIP) and Seaport Air Quality 2020 and Beyond Plan implementation at the seaport. Furthermore, the Port seeks consultants to provide air quality analyses, including greenhouse gas (GHG) analyses and health risk assessments, to support various development and operations projects throughout the seaport and airport. Qualified consulting firms are invited to submit proposals in response to this RFP. The Port intends to enter into no more than three contracts for consulting services covering the seaport and the airport. These air quality technical consulting contracts will have a term of 5 years. The selected consultants are expected to be under contract with the Port by August 2019.
