

NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF BIDS

The CITY OF OAKLAND, acting by and through its BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (the "Port"), will receive Bids via email as per the provisions of Document 00200, Instructions to Bidders, Paragraph 17, Bid Submission, until 12:00 noon on Thursday, February 18, 2021, for the following public work:

**PERFORMING EMERGENCY SPILL RESPONSE OR
EMERGENCY REPAIRS IN A HAZARDOUS ENVIRONMENT
FOR PORT OF OAKLAND FACILITIES
FOR THE PERIOD COMMENCING JULY 1, 2021
AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2022, 2023 OR 2024
OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA**

In general, the Work of this annual Contract consists of on-call furnishing of labor, materials and equipment for containment and clean-up of spills of oil, chemicals, sewage, or other hazardous and/or flammable substances; abatement of asbestos-containing materials, lead-containing paint, PCB-containing materials or materials with other hazardous components; removal and legal disposal of contaminated soil; performance of emergency utility repair work in a hazardous environment; and other related field services at Port of Oakland facilities for the period indicated. Based on past experience, the cost of Work to be performed during the period of the Contract is expected to be approximately \$150,000 per year. The work of this Contract is contingent upon the occurrence of emergency events; therefore, it is impossible to estimate the cost of work precisely.

A California Class A contractor's license, asbestos certification, and hazardous substance removal certification are required to bid this Contract. The asbestos certification may be held by the prime contractor or the subcontractor. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded any contract for the project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a).

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The Port will conduct a pre-bid meeting at 3:00 PM on Monday, February 1, 2021. Due to the Governor's Shelter-in-Place order, the meeting will be conducted via Zoom videoconferencing. The Port strongly recommends that potential Bidders attend the pre-bid meeting. The meeting will address the Port's Non-Discrimination and Small/Local Business Utilization Policy, insurance requirements, bonds, and any other special working conditions for this contract.

The Port will not conduct Site inspection tours during the Bidding Period.
