

**NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF BIDS
[REVISED BID DATE]**

The CITY OF OAKLAND, acting by and through its BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (the "Port"), will receive sealed Bids at the office of the Secretary of the Board of Port Commissioners, located at Room 629, 530 Water Street, Oakland, California, until 12:00 noon on Friday, March 16, 2018, for the following public work:

**HOWARD TERMINAL PAVEMENT REPAIR, FY18
OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA**

The work of this 35 calendar day project consists generally of furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, transportation, services and supervision required to grind and pave asphalt concrete pavement in various areas of Howard Terminal; mobilizing and demobilizing; grinding, hauling and reutilization of existing asphalt concrete (AC) at a location within the former Oakland Army Base; sweeping and tack coating the surface to accept new AC; furnishing and installing new AC; stormwater pollution protection BMPs at all drain outlets; sweeping and cleaning the site and any haul routes; and performing all associated work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$600,000.

A California Class C-12 contractor's license is required to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded any contract for the project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a).

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

This contract is subject to prevailing wage provisions, as specified in Document 00100, Invitation to Bid, and Document 00200, Instructions to Bidders, of the Project Manual.

The Port will conduct a pre-bid meeting at 10:00 AM on Monday, March 5, 2018 in the Board Room, Second Floor, Port of Oakland Building, 530 Water Street, Oakland, California.

The Port strongly recommends that potential Bidders attend the pre-bid meeting. The pre-bid meeting will last approximately one hour, and will address the Port's Non-Discrimination and Small/Local Business Utilization Policy, insurance requirements, bonds, and any other special working conditions for this contract.

The Port will conduct a Site inspection tour at 11:00 AM on Monday, March 5, 2018, immediately following the pre-bid meeting. Bidders should meet for the Site inspection tour in front of the Martin Luther King Jr Way entrance (south of Embarcadero West) to Howard Terminal, 1 Market Street, Oakland, California. Bidders who wish to participate in the tour must contact Peter Lee, at (510) 627-1350 at least 48 hours prior to the scheduled tour date and time, to confirm arrangements and register for the tour by providing the tour participant's full name, telephone number and company name. Bidders who fail to contact Peter Lee as required above may not be eligible to participate in the tour.
