



NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF BIDS

The CITY OF OAKLAND, acting by and through its BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (the "Port"), will receive Bids via email as per the provisions of Document 00200, Instructions to Bidders, Paragraph 17, Bid Submission, until 12:00 noon on Monday, August 21, 2023, for the following public work:

REHABILITATION OF SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM AT OICT (BERTHS 55-58) OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA

The work of this 300 calendar day project consists generally of furnishing all labor, materials, appliances, tools, equipment, transportation, services and supervision required to rehabilitate and replace sanitary sewer lines and manholes in the Berths 55-58 area, including, but not limited to: open cut replacement, cast in place pipe liners, construction of new manholes and cleanouts and rehabilitation of existing manholes and cleanouts, and performing all associated work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$7,100,000.

A California Class A contractor's license is required to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded any contract for the project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a).

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations.

The Port will conduct a pre-bid meeting at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, August 8, 2023 in the Exhibit Room, First Floor, Port of Oakland Building, 530 Water Street, Oakland, California. The Port strongly recommends that potential Bidders attend the pre-bid meeting. The pre-bid meeting will last approximately one hour, and will address the Port's Non-Discrimination and Small/Local Business Utilization Policy, insurance requirements, bonds, Maritime and Aviation Project Labor Agreement and any other special working conditions for this.

The Port will conduct a Site inspection tour at 3:30 PM on Tuesday, August 8, 2023, immediately following the pre-bid meeting. Bidders should meet for the Site inspection tours at 651 Maritime Street. To confirm arrangements and participate in the tour, Bidders must contact Chris Briana at cbriana@portoakland.com no later than 5:00 PM on Friday, August 4, 2023. Bidders who fail to contact Chris Briana by the deadline may not be eligible to participate in the tour.

The tour will be conducted in a manner consistent with all State and County Health Orders issued in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, including, but not limited to, the following provisions:

- The number of attendees on site at any given time will be limited.
- The amount of time that attendees are allowed on site will be limited.
- The use of face coverings and gloves, and compliance with social distancing requirements, will be mandatory.

The Port will provide additional details on the site visit safety protocols to bidders who register for the tour.

The Port will not take questions during the site tour; any questions should be emailed to the Project Engineer following the tour. The Port will provide its responses to any such questions via the Log of Responses to Bidder Questions.

The Standard Contract Provisions manual has been posted to the same location as the Plans and Project Manual.
