### **NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF BIDS [REVISED PRE-BID MEETING DATE]**

The CITY OF OAKLAND, acting by and through its BOARD OF PORT COMMISSIONERS (the "Port"), will receive Bids via email as per the provisions of Document 00200, Instructions to Bidders, Paragraph 19, Bid Submission, until 12:00 noon on Tuesday July 11, 2023, for the following public work:

#### **SEWER PIPELINE REHABILITATION AT JOINT INTERMODAL TERMINAL, OICT (BERTH 59) AND MATSON (BERTHS 60-63) OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA**

The work of this 605 calendar day project consists generally of furnishing all labor, materials, appliances, tools, equipment, transportation, services and supervision required to replace and rehabilitate approximately 12,000 linear feet of 4" to 24" sewer main, including, but not limited to: open cut replacement, pipe bursting, cast in place pipe liner, new sewer line construction, manhole and cleanout rehabilitation and new manhole and cleanout construction, and performing all associated work, all in accordance with the Contract Documents.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$10,200,000.

A California Class A contractor's license is required to bid this Contract. Joint ventures must secure a joint venture license prior to award of this Contract.

No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal or awarded any contract for the project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5, with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a).

This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations. This contract is subject to prevailing wage provisions, as specified in Document 00100, Invitation to Bid, and Document 00200, Instructions to Bidders, of the Project Manual.

The Port will conduct a pre-bid meeting at 2:00 PM on **Monday, June 26**, 2023 in the Exhibit Room, First Floor, Port of Oakland Building, 530 Water Street, Oakland, California. The Port strongly recommends that potential Bidders attend the pre-bid meeting. The pre-bid meeting will last approximately one hour, and will address the Port's Non-Discrimination and Small/Local Business Utilization Policy, insurance requirements, bonds, Maritime and Aviation Project Labor Agreement and any other special working conditions for this.

The Port will conduct a Site inspection tour at 3:30 PM on **Monday, June 26**, 2023, immediately following the pre-bid meeting. Bidders should meet for the Site inspection tours at 651 Maritime Street. Bidders who fail to contact Young Kim-Berger by the deadline may not be eligible to participate in the tour.
