Dear Secretary Buttigieg;

We write to express support for Port of Oakland's application to the United States Department of Transportation's competitive grant program for the \$49 million to redevelop the 26 acres of its Outer Harbor Terminal area.

Port of Oakland's Port Infrastructure Development Project funding would provide new pavement to support stacking operations, additional refrigeration plug racks, new LED high mast lighting, battery storage and other substation improvements, equipment charging stations, and natural vegetative bioswales to address drainage.




