



NOTICE OF SOLICITATION OF SOQS

Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Construction Management Support Services for Federally Funded Projects At The Port of Oakland

The Port of Oakland ("Port") is soliciting Statements of Qualifications (SOQs) from qualified consulting firms for providing "on-call" construction management (CM) services for federally-funded projects. The firms selected will provide CM services for various Port construction projects for a three-year period with two one-year options to extend.

This RFQ is being issued concurrently with the *Request for Qualifications (RFQ) for On-Call Construction Management Support Services for non-Federally Funded Projects at the Port of Oakland*. Qualified consulting firms may submit SOQs for both RFQs. The Port intends to select ten (10) firms to provide CM Services, four (4) of which will be subject to Federal Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) provisions incorporated into this RFQ, and six (6) of which will be subject to the Port's Non-Discrimination and Small/Local Business Utilization Policy (NDSLBP). Individual Technical Service Orders (TSO) will be issued for CM assignments on a project-by-project basis. The contract period will be three years with two one-year options to extend. The budget for all consultant CM work described by this RFQ for federally funded projects is expected to not exceed \$26,000,000 for all contracts over the initial 3 year term.

The selected CM Consultants are expected to be under contract with the Port by January 2024.

Some of the CM assignments are expected to be funded by an Airport Improvement Program (AIP) or Bipartisan Infrastructure Bill (BIL) grant through the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA), consultant CM services must comply with FAA Advisory Circular (AC) 150/5100-14E, "Architectural, Engineering, and Planning Consultant Services for Airport Grant Projects". All work must comply with FAA grant assurances, requirements and regulations, including the Department of Transportation (DOT) Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program regulations (see 49 Code of Federal Regulations, Part 26). DBEs, as defined in 49 CFR Part 26, shall have the maximum opportunity to participate in the performance of contracts financed in whole or in part with Federal funds under this agreement. Under DOT Regulations, any Port contractor must agree that it will not discriminate against any business owner because of the owner's race, color, national origin or sex in connection with the award or performance of any contract or subcontract, purchase or lease agreement or other agreements covered by the DOT Regulations.

The Port has posted this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) in digital format on a hosting website that can be accessed via the 'Current RFP's/RFQ's: Engineering Consulting Services' link at the following URL: <http://www.portofoakland.com/business/bids-rfps/rfq-engineering/>. Proposing consultants should carefully review the requirements of this RFQ to ensure that they meet all of the stated requirements.

SOQs will be received at the location, and until the time/date, specified under "RFQ Schedule" and "Instructions for Submitting SOQs", below.

Consultants interested in submitting SOQs for this work are strongly urged to attend a Pre-Submittal Meeting to be held at the time/date/location specified under "RFQ Schedule", below. At the Pre-Submittal Meeting, the Port will provide information related to the Port's insurance requirements and

Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) Program, and will answer questions regarding the proposed project, submittal requirements and the selection process.

Port policy prohibits discrimination or preferential treatment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, age (over 40), physical or mental disability, cancer-related medical condition, a known genetic pre-disposition to a disease or disorder, veteran status, marital status, or sexual orientation. The successful Respondent shall comply with the Port's non-discrimination policy and the DBE Rules and shall not discriminate against any business owner because of the owners' race, color, sex, or national origin in the award or performance of the Agreement.

To the extent that the scope of services includes work that falls under the Labor Code definition of "public works" (Cal. Labor Code Section 1720 et seq), this project will be subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR). Consultants submitting a Proposal/SOQ, and subcontractors or subconsultants performing any portion of the work that falls under the "public works" definition, must be registered with the DIR pursuant to DIR requirements prior to submission of the Proposal, and the Prime Consultant must include in its SOQ its own DIR registration number and the DIR registration numbers of all listed subcontractors and subconsultants that will participate in the "public works" portion of the scope of services.

Questions regarding this RFQ must be addressed in writing to the appropriate contact person listed under "RFQ Contacts", below. All questions not directed specifically to the primary contact person must be copied to said primary contact person. Proposers are advised that questions received less than seven (7) calendar days prior to the Proposal due date may not be answered. Where appropriate, the Port will respond in writing to proposer questions submitted in a timely fashion via an addendum or a 'Log of Responses to Proposer Questions'; see "Port Responses to Proposer Questions", below.

The Port reserves the right to reject any or all SOQs, to waive any irregularities or informalities not affected by law, to evaluate the SOQs submitted and to award the contract according to the proposal which best serves the interests of the Port.
